www.indeed.com and www.simplyhired.com are 2 powerful job listing sites with advanced search features that use spider technology to search jobs by your location and key words. Jobs are pulled from many other job boards.

www.craigslist.org - This website is especially useful for locating openings in small and midsize organizations, especially in the arts, writing & publishing, technical design and nonprofit areas.

www.linkedin.com – Specify areas of interest in the “Jobs” area and LinkedIn will deliver matching positions to your online profile

www.facebook.com- Facebook now allows companies to post job ads via their profiles. You can apply through a form pre-populated from your profile. Most effective for hourly or part-time work at smaller local companies.

www.google.com – type “jobs near me” into search bar and see jobs that match your criteria

www.careerbuilder.com – Search by location, job category, and/or keywords. Post your resume and create an account, save searches and have jobs sent to you

www.wayup.com – a job search site for students and new grads

www.monster.com - You can look for jobs, create an account and upload a resume on this megasite.

www.bayareacareers.com – select and search by specific area within the Bay Area

www.bajobs.com – Local jobs can be searched by company as well as job category and location.
